Level 3 Maths Studies

This level 3 course (formerly known as Core Maths) is a great choice if you want to choose other A levels that would benefit from a strong understanding in Maths (like the Sciences or Business Studies), but don't need a full Maths A level.

This course is new in the UK and focuses on applied Maths skills in the real world. Instead of Algebra, the content covers finance and mortgages, project management and understanding large data sets. In addition to building on GCSE Maths skills, this course teaches elements of Excel software and also requires students to complete case studies throughout the course. This is less intense than a full Maths A Level, but is worth less UCAS points so is designed to compliment three other full A Levels.



Course structure:

In addition to recapping key GCSE skills you will learn:

- Personal finance
- Data analysis and statistics
- Loans and mortgages
- ICT/Excel skills
- Critical path analysis
- Modelling and estimation
- Financial analysis
- Project management
- Gantt charts

Assessment

There are 2 exam papers, each 60 marks and 1hr 20mins. Three months ahead of the exam, supporting material will be provided so students can read around the subject and practice drawing conclusions from the data.

Entry requirements:

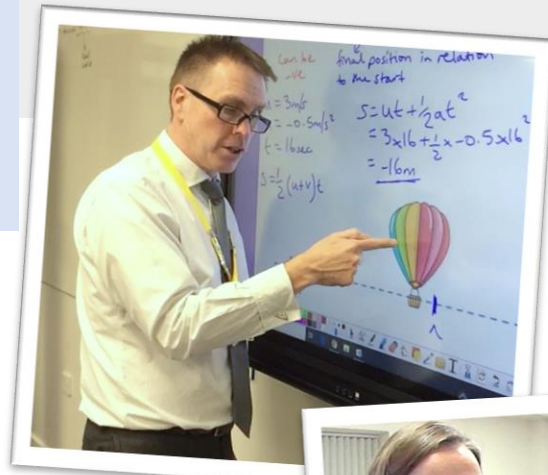
7 GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including at least grade 4 in GCSE Maths.
